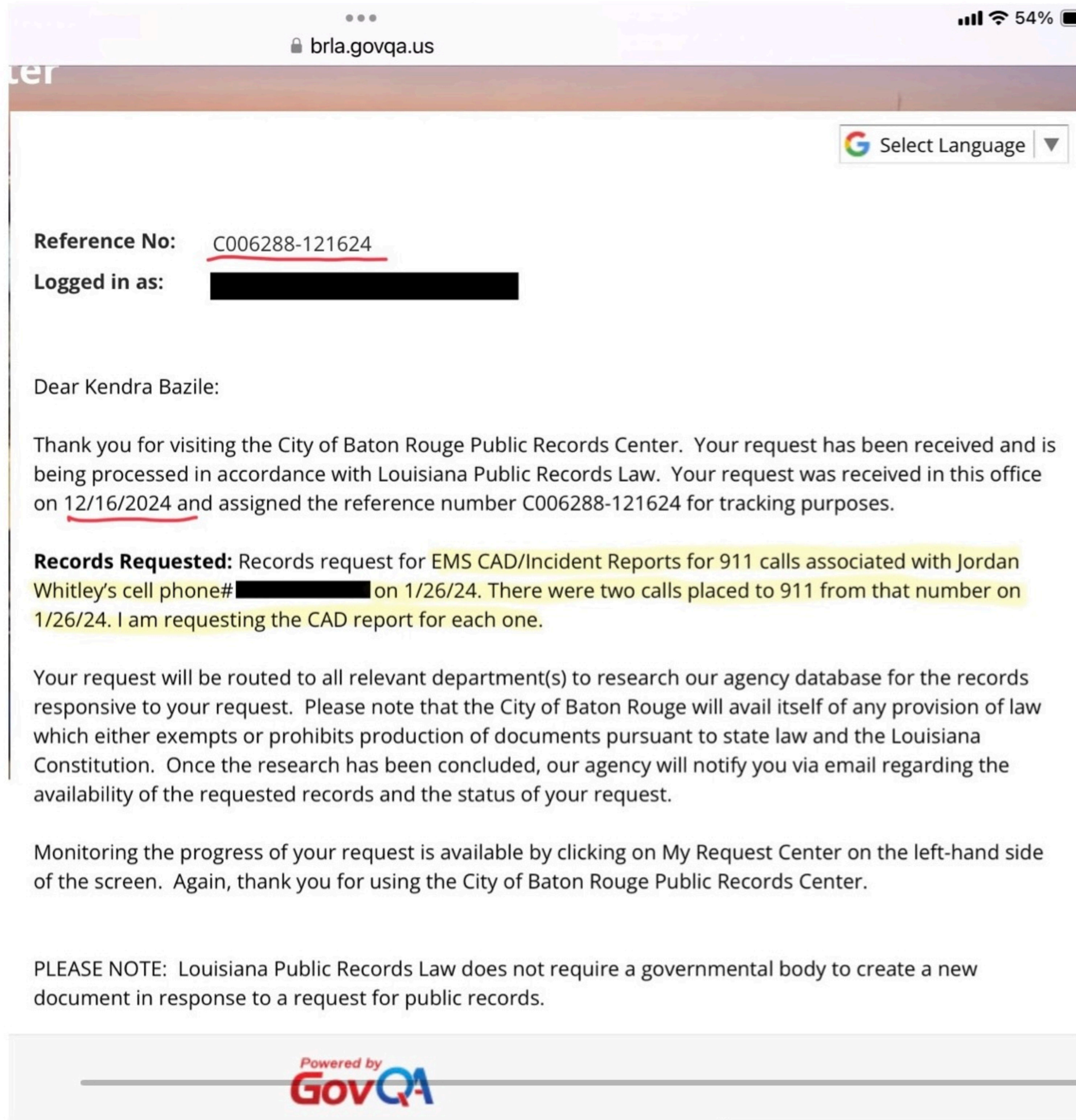

Your request will be routed to all relevant department(s) to research our agency database for the records responsive to your request.
