Details of Arrest									

On June 11, 2016, at approximately 1315 hours, I was notified by LSP-I, they received a call from a concerned citizen who was traveling north on I-49 at or about mile marker 4. The caller stated he was observing a white Ford F-150 with no license plate traveling very fast and making numerous lane changes without any regard to other vehicles on the roadway.

I was stationary on the eastbound shoulder of I-49 North. At approximately 1322 hours, I observed the vehicle in question pass my location and make two lane changes without using a signal. I initiated my lights and sirens to conduct a traffic stop. Note: It took approximately 1.5 miles for vehicle to pull onto the eastbound shoulder.

Driver exited the vehicle and was identified as Cody M. Bowlin. I informed Bowlin for the reason of the stop. I asked him for his driver's license, (Note: Bowlin was very nervous and I detected the order of marijuana.) Bowlin produced a valid Louisiana driver's license (LA DL 009208819).

Note: TFC Chris Leday arrived shortly after traffic stop to assist with my investigation.

Bowlin could not produce/provide any proof of insurance, and the vehicle showed, not insured on Think Stream.

I asked Bowlin if there was anything illegal within his vehicle, and he stated, "No." I asked if the vehicle could be searched, he stated, "My lawyer told me to never allow someone to search his vehicle." I informed Bowlin his vehicle would be getting towed due to not being insured. I also requested a K-9 unit.

While waiting on both the tow truck and the K-9 unit, I allowed Bowlin to sit in the rear passenger seat of my unit due to the heavy rain that the area was experiencing. Bowlin was adamant the vehicle was insured, and I allowed him to use his cell phone while sitting in the rear of my unit. Note: He was not able to produce any proof of insurance.

A short time later, Detective Brandon Dugas with St. Landry Parish Sheriff's Department arrived with his K-9, Dino. Refer to Deputy Dugas' report 20160605590 for details on his investigation and the K-9 alert on the driver's side front door. (Attached)


Upon receiving the K-9 alert, I conducted a complete search of Bowlin's vehicle. I located one (1) small plastic container with a green vegetable substance between the driver's side front seat and the center console. Based on both my training and experience, this substance both smelled and looked to be marijuana.

Bowlin was placed under arrest.

I placed Bowlin in handcuffs with his hands to his rear. Handcuffs were checked for proper fit and double locked. Bowlin was searched for weapons and contraband, I located one (1) 2mg Suboxone tablet, which Bowlin did not have a prescription for in his rear right pocket. He was placed in the rear passenger side of the unit and seat belted in. I transported him to the St. Landry Parish Jail where he was booked on the above charges.

NOTE: TCF Leday remained with the vehicle while I transported Bowlin to the St. Landry parish Jail. The vehicle was towed by Doucet's Towing out of Opelousas.





On June 11, 2016, I, Detective Brandon Dugas, was notified by dispatch advising Louisiana State Police, Troop I requested my assistance. Dispatch advised one of the troopers was on a traffic stop and needed a k9. Dispatch advised me the trooper's location was on Interstate 49, northbound, near mile marker 15. I advised dispatch I would be en route from my home in Eunice and advised troop I would be approximately 15 minutes.

I have been a certified k9 handler since 2010 with the NNDDA (National Narcotics Drug Detector Association). K9 "Dino" has been certified through NNDDA for 3 years. "Dino" is trained to alert on the odors of marijuana, cocaine, heroin, MDMA, and methamphetamine.

Upon arrival, I spoke with Trooper Matthew Motes. Motes advised me that he needed me to run my k9 on the vehicle.

Before my k9 could start his open air sniff around the vehicle it started to rain. I started the open air sniff at the driver side rear tail light. I was going to perform an "L pattern" search, sniffing the rear of the vehicle and passenger side. "Dino" pulled me to the driver side of the vehicle. "Dino" was sniffing the vehicle from the rear taillight to the front headlight on the driver side. "Dino" was sniffing the vehicle quick, but as "Dino" sniffed around the driver side door, I noticed his breathing changed and he started sniff slow and methodical. As I passed by the driver side front headlight "Dino" gave a quick head shot and he started sniff up and down, methodically around the front of the driver side door. "Dino" went to the rear of the driver side door, I noticed his breathing was extremely heavy, his tail was straight, his ears were pointed up, and he went to a final response. I advised Trooper Motes that my alerted to presence of a narcotic odor emitting from inside the vehicle.

During a probable cause search of the vehicle, Trooper Motes advised me he located an orange plastic container labeled "M&M's". Inside the plastic container was a green vegetable material suspected to be marijuana. Motes advised me that container was concealed between the driver seat and the center console. I stayed on scene for the duration of the search and left once the suspect was taken into custody.


