Mr. Forbes:

It has come to our attention that, in connection with Provident Disaster Resources Management, LLC's (PDRM) proposal submitted in response to the above referenced RFP, PDRM falsely represented to the ReLA Coordinator and the State of Louisiana Office of Community Development, Division of Administration that CORE Construction ("CORE") was part of PDRM's sub-contractor team. This representation is categorically untrue. To the contrary, CORE has entered into an Exclusive Teaming Agreement (the "Teaming Agreement") with Innovative Emergency Management, Inc. ("IEM"). The explicit terms of that Teaming Agreement preclude CORE from submitting as a proposed sub-contractor with any firm other than IEM.

The unauthorized inclusion of our company in their proposal has caused the concern of IEM, our true teaming partner, and contradicts PDRM's certification made as required by the RFP with the submission of the Certification Statement attached to the RFP as Attachment V. Therein PDRM certifies that: "The information contained in its response to this RFP are accurate." Clearly that certification is false.

Please consider any representation by PDRM that CORE is a part of PDRM's team inaccurate.
