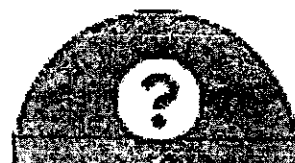

**FEDERAL DEFENDANTS' NOTICE OF RELATED CASE AND  
MOTION TO REASSIGN**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 42(a) and Local Civil Rules 40.5(a)(3) and 40.5(b)(3), Federal Defendants,<sup>1</sup> by and through undersigned counsel, hereby notify the Court of a related action, *Dantzler v. Department of Justice*, Civ. A. No. 20-1505 (TNM) (D.D.C. filed June 8, 2020). This case and *Dantzler* (1) involve common issues of fact, LCvR 40.5(a)(3)(ii); (2) grow out of the same event or transaction, LCvR 40.5(a)(3)(iv); (3) involve most of the same parties; and (4) relate to the same subject matter. A comparison of the operative complaints<sup>2</sup> in this case and *Dantzler* confirm that the factual allegations and claims for relief are nearly identical.
