FEDERAL DEFENDANTS' NOTICE OF RELATED CASE AND MOTION TO REASSIGN

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 42(a) and Local Civil Rules 40.5(a)(3) and 40.5(b)(3), Federal Defendants, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby notify the Court of a related action, *Dantzler v. Department of Justice*, Civ. A. No. 20-1505 (TNM) (D.D.C. filed June 8, 2020). This case and *Dantzler* (1) involve common issues of fact, LCvR 40.5(a)(3)(ii); (2) grow out of the same event or transaction, LCvR 40.5(a)(3)(iv); (3) involve most of the same parties; and (4) relate to the same subject matter. A comparison of the operative complaints² in this case and *Dantzler* confirm that the factual allegations and claims for relief are nearly identical.

The parties have conferred by telephone pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7(m). Plaintiff has indicated that he wants both cases to proceed before the Honorable Royce C. Lamberth, a position

Federal Defendants are the United States Department of Justice, Attorney General William Barr, the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI"), FBI Director Christopher Wray, FBI Agency Bryan Vorndran, FBI Agents Does 1-5, the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, Travis Nicholson, Keith Hill, and Rudy Sustaita in their official capacities.

Federal Defendants note that Plaintiff has pending in both actions identical motions for leave to amend his complaint. See ECF No. 19; see also Civ. A. No. 20-1505, ECF No. 20. Plaintiff has also moved to stay Dantzler. See Civ. A. No. 20-1505, ECF No. 22.

Federal Defendants construe as an opposition to this request. The School Board Defendants do not oppose the Federal Defendants' request.

Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 40.5(c), the Court should transfer this case to the Calendar and Case Management Committee for reassignment to the Honorable Trevor N. McFadden, the judge assigned to the earlier-filed *Dantzler* case, for coordinated proceedings. Federal Defendants further request that, in light of their motion seeking reassignment of this case, the Court vacate the October 19, 2020, deadline by which they must respond to the Complaint and extend their responsive pleading deadline by an additional 21 days after reassignment or, alternatively, 21 days after any denial of this motion. A proposed order accompanies this submission.
