Affiant wishes to advise the court that on 06/16/2019 at approximately 1637 hours that the Accused did violate the aforementioned charges at 8120 Jefferson Highway (LA State Troopers Association), which is within this Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana.

Deputies were dispatched to this location in reference to a shots fired call. Upon arrival, Deputies made contact with a white male at this location, David Young (W/M, 06/02/1948). Young was found to be the suspect in the shots fired incident. When Deputies approached D. Young he was asked if he heard any shots fired in the area, to which he responded "I fired a shot." D. Young was placed into handcuffs, which were checked for tightness and double locked. D. Young was advised of his rights per Miranda, which he stated he understood. For public safety I asked D. Young were was the gun he fired. He advised that it was in the desk drawer of the reception desk. Deputies located a black Smith and Wesson .380 (Serial #KBH0701) handgun inside the desk drawer and secured it.

Deputies were able to locate one spent .380 casing near the driver side door of the vehicle in the parking lot at this location. While questioning D. Young he stated he was at this location and observed an unknown person inside of his daughter's, Lauren Young (W/F, 02/08/1984), vehicle. When he asked L. Young if anyone was inside of the vehicle she stated no. D. Young then retrieved his handgun from inside the building and proceeded to the vehicle. Once at the vehicle he then pointed the handgun and the person, who he then recognized as Mendel, who is L. Young's boyfriend. D. Young then stated he ordered Mendel out of the vehicle and on to the ground because he believed Mendel was not supposed to be inside of the vehicle since L. Young stated no one was inside the vehicle. He stated that he ordered Mendel out of the vehicle, and onto the ground. D. Young held him at gun point and as he began to call 911, Mendel abruptly got up and began running around the vehicle at which time he fired one round into the air. D. Young stated that his intentions were to scare Mendel because he wanted Mendel to know not to come around his property.

A short time later, I contacted L. Young who was present during the incident. She advised that she was at this location chasing the office. L. Young further stated, when D. Young found out her baby's father, Jody Mendel (W/M, 06/15/1982), was in her car he became upset. She stated D. Young grabbed his handgun and then approached Mendel who was seated inside the Ford on the driver side rear seat. L. Young stated D. Young pointed the gun at Mendel's head, began cursing at him, and ordered him out of the vehicle. She further stated at some point D. Young fired one shot into the air and which time Mendel took off running down Jefferson Highway. L. Young was asked if D. Young knew what Mendel looked like and she stated yes he knew who he is and meet him several times. She also stated D. Young does not like Mendel because he does not take care of his kid (D. Young's grandchild).

Deputies were able to locate Mendel, who is the victim of the shots fired call, at 7975 Jefferson Place Boulevard. Once he returned to 8120 Jefferson Highway with Deputies he was questioned about the incident. Mendel stated he was seated on the driver side rear seat when D. Young approached the door with a black handgun. He then stated D. Young ordered him out of the vehicle at gunpoint and then ordered him onto the ground. Mendel stated that D. Young held him at gunpoint, not allowing him to leave, for an extended period of time. After this time, he stated he got up in order to run away and he heard a shot being fired. Mendel advised that he did not see what direction D. Young was pointing the handgun.

Deputies received a video of the incident from an anonymous complainant. In the video you can see D. Young standing near the vehicle, Mendel seated on the ground at the driver side rear door, and L. Young standing at the rear of the vehicle. You can see D. Young pointing an object (admitted by D. Young to be a handgun) in the direction of Mendel. During this time L. Young can be seen speaking to D. Young as if to plead with him. She is then seen walking towards D. Young as if to intervene with him pointing the gun at Mendel, at which time D. Young pushes her away. After one - two minutes you see Mendel stand up and take off running around the front of the vehicle with D. Young chasing him. From the Deputies perspective of the video the handgun was pointed in the general direction of Mendel when you hear one round from D. Young's handgun being fired. It appeared that the firearm was aimed slightly above Mendel's head.

Due to D. Young holding Mendel, who he knew, on the ground at gun point for an extended period of time and then fire the weapon in the general direction of Mendel, D. Young was arrested for 14:37.4 - Aggravated Assault with a Firearm, 14:94 - Illegal Use of Weapon (Handgun), and 14:46.1 False Imprisonment with a Dangerous Weapon (Handgun). He was transported to the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison where he was booked accordingly.


