

The accused was present in court represented by Mr. Rodney Messina. Mr. David deBlieux, Assistant District Attorney, was present for the State of Louisiana. Counsel for the accused advised the Court that the accused wished to withdraw his former plea of not guilty and enter a plea of guilty to the amended charge of Aggravated Assault with a Firearm. The Court inquired of the accused if this was the defendant's desire, and the accused responded affirmatively. The reporter electronically		

	<p>and stenographically recorded voir dire examination of the accused relative to his understanding of the significance of his proposed plea. The Court then explained to the accused the nature of and elements required to constitute the crime charged against him and the maximum penalty assessable for the crime charged. The Court questioned the accused as to the circumstances of the offense and found a factual basis for the defendant's guilty plea. The accused was advised that the accused possessed certain constitutional rights that would be surrendered upon acceptance of a guilty plea, namely: the right to a trial by jury or by the Court, the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses testifying on behalf of the State, the right to compulsory process, and the right against compulsory self-incrimination. In response to examination by the Court, the accused indicated an understanding of these rights and waived said rights. The Court further examined the accused as to his educational background and as to whether or not he understood his rights and the waiver of those rights. The Court further inquired of the accused if any force, threats, promises, or inducements were used or offered in order to compel a guilty plea. The accused gave a negative response. Whereupon, the Court being of the opinion that the accused understood the significance of his guilty plea and was knowingly, intentionally, and intelligently waiving his right to plead not guilty, ruled that it would accept the defendant's guilty plea. The Court sentenced the accused to 4 years at home incarceration to be supervised by the Department of Corrections, Probation and Parole with the following conditions (1) standard conditions of home incarceration; (2) no criminal conduct; (3) curfew of 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., electronic monitoring, home visits; (4) allowed to coach youth football, attend church, and go to work; (5) \$50.00 per month to probation and parole; (6) weapon is to be forfeited and destroyed; (7) continue mental health treatment if necessary. This matter was reassigned to November 17, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. to show proof. The Court advised the accused of his right to appeal his conviction and his sentence within thirty days from this date and his right to post-conviction relief within two years from this date. The Court further advised the accused that a Motion to Reconsider Sentence is to be filed within thirty days from this date.</p>
