The most recent incident of abuse which caused petitioner to file this petition happened on or about

2/21/2023 (month/day/year), at which time the defendant did

Re: my children: their father had been in a very bad mood all day, he began drinking around noon, at which point they could tell he was drunk, his behavior worsen he was verbally infirming the kids about how terrible their step mother is, how she has sex with other men. He took my daughter to walmart, she was scared because he was driving drunk, he left her alone in walmart to get groceries. She was very scared and nervous, she said two employees stopped to ask if she was OK. Her father returned home to check on her was randomly feeling people his wife is psycho. They went back home, he continued to drink, made them try to cook chili and she accidentally burned it. Their father was irred and started slamming the door open to air the house out. He beat the door so hard so many times, he busted the wall he then screamed to our son that he is a fuck up & fucking up in school. He screamed to our daughter she fucked up making chili & started screaming up. He started trying to pull metal brackets out of the wall from the door damage. He left went to the app house the kids were scared, ran to the front yard & called their grandmother, maternal suther. Their Dad left them home alone went to the garage of their stepmother where the drugs car altercation took place. Kids called her, brought her back to the home with them one. Kids witnessed father in a comatose state of panic, yelling. She wanted to bedroom they saw blood on her mother's pants on face. They heard loud talking at which point police came & made arrest. Children would have severe drug usage through the entire day.

Past incidents: Numerous times have witnessed their father drink verbally, physically & mentally abuse stepmother. Father often gets angry over stepmother drinking sex with another man which their spirals anger to physical abuse or damage to property where he always name items in front of kids. Witnessed father try to run stepmother out while she was taking trash cans out. Kids said he often leaves them home alone when he is angry & drinking. Degraded their stepmother to their has witnessed hitting, shoving, pushing, torn clothes marks on stepmother. Our son said recently his dad was angry over his side by side not working. He told our son to open the door of the side by side. He pushed him out, our son landed on his back, his dad then got out kicked him in his back, his clothes, shoved him against the side by side hitting him. He was a 5'10" tall kid, he then made our son carry their hunting guns to work home. He then was drunk left home, was pulled over for drinking. An SWMOM went & picked him up. When they came back home he began physically & verbally abusing her. Kids were scared & stayed in their room with mother.

Paragraph 9: Requests for relief

Because of the immediate and present danger of abuse, petitioner requests that an ex parte Temporary Restraining Order be issued immediately without bond.
