Dear Mr. Painter:

This is to update our May 11, May 17, and June 23 responses to your public records request letter dated May 6, 2011, and received by our office on May 9, 2011. As you are aware, the Louisiana Office of Inspector General (OIG) has been involved in litigation with you in the recent past in the 19th Judicial District Court. Because of that, we would not normally communicate directly with you, but instead would communicate through your legal counsel. However, in your letter of May 6, you state: "This request is for me personally and does not involve any attorney representing me on any matters. Under State law respond directly to me." Given that statement, we are, with this letter, updating you on where we stand on your public records request of May 6.

In your letter, you make eight requests. We are now able to further update our earlier response on item 4.

4. "[A] total number of criminal histories that each person in your office has accessed since the granting of this 'new authority under the Jindal administration.'"


