

SEARCH WARRANT

STATE OF LOUISIANA

PARISH OF EAST BATON ROUGE

TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS in and for the Parish aforesaid:

WHEREAS an affidavit has been made before me upon the oath of Shane Evans, Investigator for the State of Louisiana, Office of State Inspector General, alleging that the office of the former Commissioner of the Louisiana Office of Alcohol and Tobacco Control (La. ATC), located within the La. ATC office at 8585 Archives Avenue, Suite 220 Baton Rouge, Louisiana, Dell desktop computer (State of Louisiana ID# 714-07-001784), Dell laptop computer (State of Louisiana ID# 714-07-001767), Blackberry telephone (PIN: 314D22AE) and state issued 2010 Dodge Charger vehicle (Lic. Tag # THN293) are places where evidence of the crime of Stalking and Computer Tampering as defined in La. R.S. 14:40.2 and 14:73.7 to wit:

- Electronic records and/or electronic logs that are evidence of illegal access or access exceeding the user's legitimate statutory authority to conduct background checks not pertaining to law enforcement matters.
- Electronic records and/or electronic logs that contain email, text messages or Blackberry PIN messages that may contain data obtained through the illegal access or access exceeding the user's authorization to State of Louisiana and United States Government criminal history databases, and State of Louisiana Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) databases.
 - Any and all electronic devices that are capable of analyzing, creating, displaying, converting, or transmitting electronic or magnetic computer impulses or data that are used by, owned by or accessible by any person at this office. These devices include, but are not limited to, computers (including self-contained "laptop" or "notebook" computers), computer components, computer peripherals, word processing equipment, modems, monitors, printers, keyboards, acoustic couplers, cables, plotters, encryption circuit boards, optical scanners, external hard drives, and other computer-related electronic or physical devices that serve to transmit or receive information to or from a computer.
 - Any and all information and/or data stored in the form of magnetic or electronic coding on computer media or on media capable of being read by a computer or with the aid of computer-related equipment. This media includes, but is not limited to, floppy diskettes, fixed hard disks, universal serial bus "thumb" drives, removable hard disk cartridges, zip disks, compact disk (CD) storage devices, tapes, laser disks, videocassettes, "smart" cellular devices and any other media that is capable of storing magnetic coding.
 - Any and all instructions or programs stored in the form of electronic or magnetic media that are capable of being interpreted by a computer or related components. The items to be seized include, but are not limited to, operating systems, application software (like word processing, graphics, or spreadsheet programs), utility programs, compilers, interpreters, communications programs, and any other programs or software used to communicate with computer hardware or peripherals either directly or indirectly via telephone lines, radio, or other means of transmission.
- Printed hardcopy documents including photographs, criminal histories, handwritten notations that consist of personal information obtained through the illegal access or access exceeding the user's authorization to State of Louisiana and United States

Government criminal history databases, and State of Louisiana Department of Motor Vehicle databases.

- Printed maps, written directions, addresses or other documents containing the personal information of a female stalking victim pursued by Mr. Painter.

are secreted or concealed, and whereas the affidavit submitted in support of the request for this search warrant indicates that the affiant has shown probable cause for its issuance,

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to search the aforesaid office of the former Commissioner of the Louisiana Office of Alcohol and Tobacco Control (La. ATC), located within the La. ATC office at 8585 Archives Avenue, Suite 220 Baton Rouge, Louisiana, Dell desktop computer (State of Louisiana ID# 714-07-001784), Dell laptop computer (State of Louisiana ID# 714-07-001767), Blackberry telephone (PIN: 314D22AE) and state issued 2010 Dodge Charger vehicle (Lic. # THN293), where evidence of the crime of Stalking and Computer Tampering in violation of La. R.S. 14:40.2 and 14:73.7: and when the thing to be searched is a dwelling or other structure, this writ includes all other structures, vehicles and places on the premises where the things may be found, and if the things specified be found there, to seize and bring them before this Court,


YOU ARE FURTHER ORDERED to seize any and all of the above specified and bring them to the Offices of the Louisiana Inspector General for further analysis.
