

Dear Warden:

I am Co-founder and CEO of Louisiana United International, Inc. (LUI), a nonprofit civil, constitutional, and human rights organization headquartered in Slidell, Louisiana. Please be advised that on December 17, 2020, I filed before the Twenty-Ninth Judicial Court for the Parish of St. Charles, Louisiana a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus on behalf of long-time LUI member, Reverend Errol Victor, Sr., naming as respondent Alvin Robinson, Warden of the Nelson Coleman Correctional Center:

Despite the lack of authority to do so alleged by my linked petition, Mr. Robinson apparently arranged for Reverend Victor to be placed in your custody. Although in doing so, Robinson may have thwarted jurisdiction over the matter of Louisiana's Twenty-Ninth Judicial Court, his purported authority and all corresponding, purported authority to detain Reverend Victor remains in dispute.

It is my understanding that Reverend Victor is symptomatic for what may be COVID-19 infection. Your detention of him is keeping Reverend Victor from securing the medical care of his choice as any American should have who is neither convicted of any crime nor ineligible for pre-trial release per U.S. law. As clearly this predicament could soon prove fatal for Reverend Victor, are you willing to work with me to quickly bring this matter before an appropriate court to answer as to your authority for detaining him? Your assured cooperation in that regard is quite important -- arguably essential -- given that my unilateral petitioning for a related writ is so easily made futile as Mr. Robinson has demonstrated.
